

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING YOUR CME CREDITS

Eligible for 24 CME credits (EACCME) / 24 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™

EUROPE

IMCAS is accredited by the European Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (EACCME) to provide CME accredited activities for physicians. The EACCME is an institution of the European Union of Medical Specialists (UEMS).

European CME credits are available for all specialists (subject to particular agreements between your country and the EACCME).

In order to apply for your credits, follow these instructions:

1. Contact your local medical authorities in your home country in order to validate the European CME credits and to convert them into your national CME credits.
2. Send your Certificate of attendance to your local medical authorities.

USA

The American Medical Association (AMA) has an agreement of mutual recognition of continuing medical education (CME) credit with the European Union of Medical Specialists (UEMS).

Physicians (MDs, DOs or equivalent international degree) may have their EACCME European CME Credits (ECMEC@s) converted to AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™ by applying to the AMA.

In order to apply for conversion of EACCME credits into AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™ (conversion ratio 1=1), follow these instructions:

1. Fill in the application form for EACCME Credit Conversion on AMA website (<https://www.ama-assn.org/system/files/2019-01/eaccme-application.pdf>)
2. Once completed, submit your application by fax or mail, along with your EACCME Credit Certificate and processing fee. A certificate awarding AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™ will be e-mailed within 4 weeks.
